



## **Sustainable Procurement Policy**

Great Eagle Holdings Limited (the “Company”) is committed to mitigating its environmental and social impacts when making procurement decisions. The Sustainable Procurement Policy (the “Policy”) stipulates the Company’s commitment in purchasing products (goods and services) which have lesser or reduced environmental and social impacts when compared with competing products that serve the same purpose.

The Policy is applicable to the Company and its subsidiaries (the “Group”). Subsidiaries should establish their own policy or specification relating to this Policy. The Policy complements and should be adopted in conjunction with the Company’s Supplier Code of Conduct.

The following factors should be considered, where appropriate, during procurement:

- Minimise or eliminate toxic, environmentally harmful and biodiversity depletion products;
- Avoid single-use disposable products with reusables or recyclables;
- Maximise products from well-managed sources and/or with a large percentage of recycled content;
- Consider the recyclability of products so as to reduce waste;
- Minimise or eliminate packaging;
- Select products which contribute to the reduction of energy and water consumption as well as carbon emissions in order to mitigate climate change
- Consider potential health hazards during consumption of products;
- Explore procurement from suppliers which support local economy or socially vulnerable groups;
- Review procurement processes regularly to incorporate sustainable procurement practices.
